Growing up, I remember the rhymes "when 2 vowels go walking, the 1st one does the talking" and "I before E except after C and sounding as A in neighbor and weigh."

The diphthongs are ew, oi, oo, ou, ow, oy, au and aw. Practice with Diphthong Words. Diphthongs can be a challenge for reading and writing because students will be working on new sounds. These words do not allow children to simply sound out words as they have done when they began reading.

A digraph can be of two types. It can either be a consonant digraph or a vowel digraph. The consonant digraph consists of a team of two consonants. Some common consonant digraphs are ch, sh, th, ph, ng, etc. The vowel digraph is a team of two vowels that blend together to make a single sound. Here are some examples of common vowel digraphs.

Some common diphthongs include: /oi/, /oo/, and /ow/. Notice that the vowel sounds may look like a combination of vowel and consonant. Our first example, /oi/, isn't always spelled like oi in words. You can, however, hear this in the word soil or foil. But you can also hear how this diphthong sounds in the word toy.
