As public service ethics is now construed, one cannot be a "civil servant" and be in public disagreement with legally constituted political authorities (Trow 1997). A public servant can voice disagreement with a public policy privately, but if this does not result in a change of policy, the only acceptable courses of action that remain are exit or loyalty (Hirschman 1970; Harmon 1995).
