September 1, 1943 (Wednesday) Anon Göth, the Nazi commandant of the Kraków-Plaszów concentration camp, decreed that the Jewish prisoners would no longer be allowed to work in the factories in neighboring Plaszów, including the one operated by Oskar Schindler. Having driven the German and Italian troops from North Africa and Sicily, the Allies decided to invade Italy in September 1943. Landing in Calabria and south of Salerno, British and American forces pushed inland.
